Dr. Halle Dimsdale-Zucker uses behavioral, neural, and computational approaches to study how context (e.g., temporal, spatial) influences what we remember and how our memories are represented by the brain across the lifespan.



Dr. Ian Ballard uses behavioral, neural, and computational approaches to study how we make adaptive decisions. His long-term research goal is to develop strategies and treatments for reducing maladaptive decision-making.



Dr. Hayden Schill Hendley studies visual perception, memory, and learning within applied domains such as radiology and the classroom.



Dr. Stephen Antonoplis will be starting in 2024. He uses behavioral and computational approaches to study how people interact with the social structures they inhabit. He studies who gets resources and who is part of "us."
